According to official data released on May 31, the Indian economy recorded a growth of 6.1 percent in the fourth quarter of the fiscal year 2022-23. This strong performance contributed to an annual growth rate of 7.2 percent.

#### **GDP per Capita**




According to the National Statistical Office, the estimated annual per capita (net national income) at current prices for the year 2022-23 is reported to be Rs 1,72,000.

#### Trade Knowledge - Payment Terms

#### What are Payment terms?

Payment Terms are a crucial part of International Trade, based on which exporters and importers decide how the final payment is to be processed. It's up to the two parties to decide or negotiate these terms.

There's always a risk involved when it comes to the recovery of invoice amounts; and in cases of exports, the risk is even higher due to the physical distance between the two parties and diversities in the legal structures of the two countries.

To minimize the risk and facilitate the process different types of payments are made available to importer and exporters by which they can enter into mutual agreements. Some payment methods are more favorable for the buyer and some are more favorable for supplier. What payment terms will they transact with, depends upon the trading history and relationship between the two parties.

#### **Most Common Payment Terms**

There are 5 types of payment terms and conditions in export. They are as follows:

- 1. Open Account
- 2. Documentary Collection
- 3. Letter of Credit
- 4. Cash in Advance
- 5. Consignment

#### 1. Open Account

The Seller has agreed to a full credit to the buyer. In the Open account payment in International Trade, the buyer receives the goods shipped by the exporter and then makes the payment at the end of an agreed credit period. The credit period can be of a fixed duration – 30 days, 60 days, 90 days, etc. There is a gap between the date of receipt of the purchase order and the date of receipt of payment, with activities like production and shipping to be concluded in between.

The time gap involved in this method puts a burden on the working capital situation of the exporter.

#### 2. Documentary Collection

In this payment method, both parties involve their respective banks to complete the payment. The remitting bank represents the exporter while a collecting bank works on behalf of the buyer. Once the exporter ships the goods, they can submit the shipping documents and a collecting order to the remitting bank, who in turn will send these to the collecting bank along with the collection instructions. This is then passed on to the buyer, on whose payment the collecting bank transfers the amount to the remitting bank. Finally, the exporter receives the amount from the remitting bank. Documentary collection may be 'at sight' or after a time-lapse.

There are 2 types of Documentary Collections: -

#### a) Cash Against Documents / Document against Payment (D/P)

CAD payment term / DP in export, happens when the buyer needs to pay the amount due at sight. This payment is made before the documents are released by the buyer's bank (collecting bank). It is also known as sight draft or cash against documents.

#### b) Document Against Acceptance

DA payment term in export, is an arrangement where the buyer is required to make the payment only after a specific duration. In this mode, the buyer accepts the time draft and makes a promise to pay. Once this acceptance is received, the bank can release the documents to the buyer.

#### 3. Letter of Credit

This is a safe and common international trade payment mechanism. The buyer's bank gives a written commitment to the seller, called a Letter of Credit. It is an assurance to the exporter that the buyer's payment will be settled as per the agreed timeline and will be subject to the agreed terms and conditions.

#### 4. Cash in Advance


This is by far the safest & the best mode of payment term in international trade for the exporter, in which they ship the goods to the buyer only after the receipt of payment from the buyer. Depending on the terms agreed upon, the payment may be full or partial. However, since in this case the buyer takes on the bulk of the risk associated with the transaction, most importers are unwilling to enter into cash-advance agreements.

#### 5. Consignment

Consignment method of payment in International Trade is a variation of open account in which payment is sent to the exporter after the goods have been sold by the foreign distributor to the end customer. The key to succeed in exporting on consignment is to partner with a reputable and trustworthy foreign distributor or a third-party logistics provider.


The global tea market was a behemoth in 2023, generating a staggering US\$120.7 billion in revenue. That's a sip (pun intended) of just how much the world loves its tea!

#### **Consumption Habits:**

The world collectively sipped 7.3 billion kilograms of tea in 2023, with an average person consuming 0.89 kilograms.

#### The Global Tea Market:


- The global tea market was valued at around 122.2 billion U.S. dollars in 2022, and is expected to rise to 160 billion dollars by 2028.
- Tea has a long history of popularity worldwide.
- Today, China is still the leader in tea production. India following at the 2nd position.



#### Tea Market of India:

- India is world's 4th largest exporter of tea. India has filled up the export gap left by Sri Lanka's reduced supply.
- There are thousands of varieties of tea, the four main types being black, green, white, and oolong, all of which are produced from the same plant.
- The Indian tea market size reached 1.2 Million Tons in 2022. Looking forward, the market expected to reach 1.5 Million Tons by 2028, exhibiting a growth rate (CAGR) of 4.5% during 2023-2028
- India imported \$54.7M in Tea in 2022, becoming the 36th largest importer of Tea in the world. India imports tea primarily from Kenya, Vietnam, Iran, etc.
- In fiscal year 2023, United Arab Emirates was the leading importer of tea from India with an export value of about 13 billion Indian rupees. The second leading importer was Russia with an export value of more than seven billion Indian rupees.

#### **Processing of Tea:**

- Colorimetric and chromatography techniques have been reported in several stages of tea processing that are expensive, laborious and inaccurate, and time-consuming. It's very important to know the processing of tea, type of tea, safety & quality evaluation, standard & emerging techniques, aroma and health benefits of tea.
  - 1. Plucking of Tea leaves
  - 2. Withering and Oxidization / Fermentation
  - 3. Drying & Grading
  - 4. Packaging

#### Processing methods of Tea:

- Basically, it is CTC or Orthodox tea.
- CTC (crush, tear and curl) is the method of processing this black tea, where tea leaves are passed through a series of cylindrical rollers with hundreds of sharp teeth that crush, tear, and curl the tea into small, hard pellets. is machine processed and fully oxidized (black) tea. CTC tea tends to be less expensive and lesser quality than Orthodox tea.

- Orthodox tea refers to the tea which is made or processed using traditional method. Orthodox teas are generally bright and brisk and have a multilayered flavor profile. Orthodox Tea is produced using the traditional methods of Tea production which includes plucking, withering, rolling, oxidation and drying.
- Virtually all premium tea is made through orthodox manufacture, which is a batch process and consequently more time consuming & expensive. CTC is a more mechanized process, primarily used for the production of tea bag grades.



#### Primarily there are 5 types of tea:

- Black: Black tea has been allowed to oxidize fully before being fired (dried), and
  the many chemical reactions that have occurred produce a dark, very complex
  tea. All of the vegetal qualities of the leaf are gone and replaced with a depth of
  character unparalleled in the food world. The liquor produced ranges from dark
  amber to a black that would rival coffee.
- **Green :** Green tea is another type of tea made from the camellia sinensis plant. Green teas often brew up a light green or yellow color, and tend to have a lighter body and milder taste. They contain about half as much caffeine as black tea.
- Oolang: Oolong tea is allowed to oxidize partially and thus produces a more complex, darker liquor, and sits on the scale between a green and a black tea. The liquor produced, therefore, can range from a greenish yellow, to a dark amber.

- Matcha: Matcha is a type of powdered green tea popular in Japan. It can be consumed on its own when whisked with water, and can also be added to lattes, smoothies, and baked goods. Matcha has a smooth, rich flavor with notes of umami and just a hint of bitterness.
- White: White tea is made from the immature buds of the tea plant that are
  picked and processed before they have had time to 'ripen' and develop many of
  the characteristics that are generally associated with tea. They tend to have
  much less caffeine than any of the other tea varieties. They are not allowed to be
  oxidized.


#### **Quality Parameters of Tea:**

Some of the quality parameters include:

- theaflavins,
- · thearubigins,
- high polymerized substances,
- total liquor color and
- total soluble solids.
- packaging

Theaflavins is directly related to price and quality of tea as it contributes with tea brightness. Thearubigins is oxidized catechins with complex condensation.

In tea quality testing, the tea is analyzed in terms of its physical appearance like color, size, flavor and taste. Also, the other analysis includes testing for any presence of chemicals, heavy metals, toxins and so on.



#### Packaging of Tea:

#### Air tight packing is needed to keep the color and aroma intact.

- Plastic Containers
- Paper Boards foldable
- Aluminum Tin
- Cannisters
- Standup Pouches
- Barrier Bags: Barrier bags are among the best bags for tea leaves.
- Nylon (PA) is a common material used for tea packaging as it offers good barrier properties against oxygen, moisture, and aroma. It is also quite strong and durable, making it ideal for storing and shipping tea.

Packaging must retain the flavor / aroma, color and air-tight. Moisture should not enter the packaging.

#### **Pricing and Margin:**

- Depending upon the process of tea leaves and type of tea, the pricing is concluded.
- Tea is a taster's market. The price per kilogram would vary from 400 INR to 10,000 INR. So, this is a high profit product, if selected the right type of tea.
